

The Abstract Preparation Guidelines

- Scientific materials must be original, must not have been previously presented at any international meetings, and must not have been previously published.
- Prepare the abstract as a Microsoft Word document.
- Abstract should be clear, concise, typed in English using **Times New Roman** typeface (**1.5 space, font size 12 points**) with all margins at least 2.5 cm., **and should not exceeding 300 words** excluding title, author names, affiliations, and key words.
- **Title:** The title page should have the title, full names and degrees of each author, each author's affiliation, and the name and address of the corresponding author. The title length should not exceed 25 words.
- **Authors:** Full names of all authors should be listed without degrees and titles. The presenting authors should be listed first.
- **Email of the corresponding author** should be given.
- **Main text:** The abstract body must be in text only and must be comprised of one paragraph without indentation. Pictures, graphs, tables, or special characters are not allowed. Standard abbreviations may be used, except in titles.
- **Keywords:** Five suitable keywords must be given at the end of the abstract.
